	<p><b>Box Paste</b> When pasting box copy data, a dialog will appear that asks whether you want to execute normal pasting or box pasting.</p>	×	☉

	<p><b>Paragraph Number</b> Paragraph Numbers are also shown in the find results window. The numbers will be automatically updated when the document was edited.</p>	⊙	⊙
	<p><b>Replace in Find Results window</b> For the complicated replace that can't be expressed with regular expressions, find target strings at first and then choose the targets manually and replace them in the find results window.</p>	⊙	⊙
